Take a trip to historic **Gettysburg** and into the heart of **Amish Country** on this **Pennsylvania** adventure. We'll learn about the iconic battle that defined the **Civil War** as well as cultures and lifestyles of the Amish and Mennonite people who settled the farmlands of Lancaster County. We arrive in **Gettysburg** and check into **The Hilton Garden Inn** featuring a restaurant and bar, pool and a full hot breakfast each morning. This evening dinner is at the historic **Dobbins Tavern**. On Day 2 we meet our guide for a tour of Gettysburg, its graveyards and 19th Century homes that still have bullet marks. Our tour ends at **The Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor's Center**. Admire displays of military artifacts and watch the film '**A New Birth of Freedom**' which follows the beginnings of the War to Lincoln's famous Address. At the **Cyclorama** we view details of the battles in miniature with troop movements lit up and described. Enjoy lunch on own followed by a guided **Battlefield Tour**. Your **Park Ranger Guide** will bring to life the time line and locations of the deadliest battle ever fought on US soil, with stories about Big and Little Round Top, the Wheat Field, artillery missions and Charges. Afterwards, we visit the home and farm of **President Dwight & Mamie Eisenhower**. This evening we visit **Adams Winery** for a tasting followed by dinner at **Hickory Bridge Farm**. On Day 3, we check out and visit the **Lincoln Train Museum**, celebrating the courage, brilliance and faith of our 16th President. Hear about the writing on the train from Washington of

The Gettysburg Address and the harrowing and heroic events of his **Funeral Train**. Afterwards we enjoy a train ride aboard the **Scenic Gettysburg Rail Line** that takes us past battlefields, towns and countryside. We have lunch on own in downtown Gettysburg before we head to **Lancaster** and check into **The Country Inn of Lancaster** which features Amish quilts in each room. This evening enjoy dinner and a Broadway style show (TBA) at the **Dutch Apple Dinner Theater**. On Day 4 we tour **Amish Country** with a local guide, then spend time at **Kitchen Kettle Village** to shop for unique local goods and enjoy lunch on own. Next we visit an authentic **Amish home** for a tour, then arrive at **Sight and Sound Theater** to see an incredible Biblical musical show featuring a cast of hundreds depicting scenes of the Bible accompanied by live animals, visual and audio effects that will leave you astounded. (Show TBA.) After the show enjoy an incredible dinner at **Miller's Smorgasbord**. On Day 5, we visit the local Farmer's Market before heading for home, with meal and comfort stops en route. *Please submit deposit with Reservation Form.*
