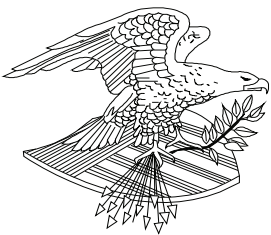
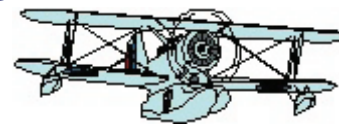

West Point & Rhinebeck

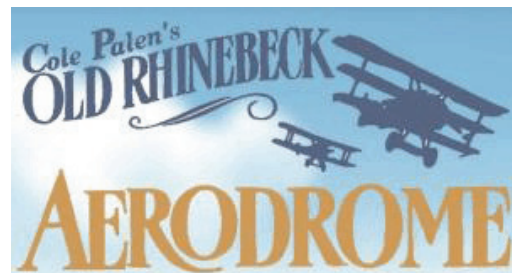
September 13 - 14, 2026 * 2 days/2 meals



We'll journey to the Hudson River Valley - a region of fjord-like beauty where the Hudson cuts through the Appalachian Mountain Range. Our first destination is the historic village of Rhinebeck and the **Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome**, a living history museum of vintage aircraft, antique vehicles and engines. We'll first visit the museum with a guided tour and then have lunch on our own, followed by the **"WW1 Dog Fight Spectacular"** – an **Air Show** featuring World War I era fighter planes with a hero, a heroine (Cheers!) who combat the villainous Black Baron of Rhinebeck (Boo!) - the show also includes pyrotechnics, WW1 tanks and vintage era Automobiles. After the show we depart for West Point and check into the **Holiday Inn Express**. Dinner tonight is at **The Hudson Valley River Inn**. Located 100 feet from the river this classic inn circa 1932 offers warmth and comfort with its antiques and period furniture for a fine dining experience. After breakfast and check-out on Day 2 we will visit **West Point** home to the US Military Academy campus and take time to visit the fascinating Military Museum, which houses the oldest and largest public collection of militaria in the Western Hemisphere.



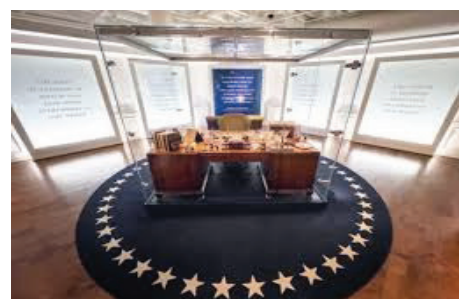
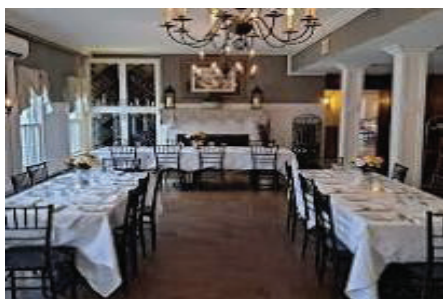
Afterward, we enjoy a 2 hour guided tour of the **Military Academy** - 'History of West Point' featuring the gothic **Cadet Chapel**, **West Point Cemetery**, **Parade Grounds**, **Michie Stadium** and scenic **Trophy Point** overlooking the majestic Hudson River. Our guide will indulge you with the history of the institution and it's **Revolutionary War** past citing battles, strategies and folklore. We will then travel to Hyde Park where we will first visit **Springwood - the home of FDR**. Take time to tour the magnificent house and gardens. Our last stop will be the **FDR Library** where you can have lunch on own at the cafeteria and visit fascinating exhibits about America's 32nd President .
