That's it for now, I hope to greet you at the next club meeting, and if I miss doing so, tap me on the shoulder and introduce yourself.

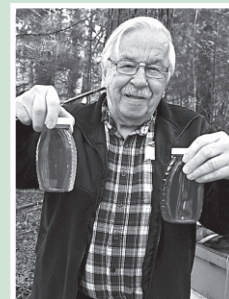
