Next are the islands of St. Pierre & Miquelon, the last remaining French territory in North America where you can explore wilderness and marine life. We dock next in **St. John, Newfoundland**, Canada's oldest city combining small town charm and big city culture. We'll enjoy two leisurely days at sea before arriving in Nuuk, Greenland's capital at the mouth of an expansive fjord. Discover friendly boutiques, vibrant cafes and a fjord system populated by whales, seals, walruses and more. From Nuuk we will visit two more ports in Greenland that have been inhabited for nearly 4,000 years. Paamiut is a former fishing village that is now home base for outdoor adventures from hiking to kayaking, birding and wildlife tours. Finally we'll spend a day in South Greenland's largest town, Qaqortoq, filled with history, culture, Norse ruins and hot springs. From Greenland we spend two relaxing days at sea en route to Iceland and its amazing natural wonders. First is Akureyri, nestled along a breathtaking fjord and the center of Iceland's folk culture. Enjoy museums, botanical gardens, Nordic cuisine and the world's northernmost golf course. Next is Isafjordur in the remote Westfjords region of Iceland, with its mountainous landscape and 15th Century historic sites. Finally we dock in the capital of Reykjavik, a photographer's dream with stunning terrain, hot springs, lava flows and a flourishing music and restaurant scene that rivals any in Europe. Here we will disembark our cruise ship and meet our local guide for a scenic tour of the region before checking into our 4-star hotel where we'll enjoy a 3-course dinner.
