Yellowstone & Parks of the Northern Rockies

with GLACIER & GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARKS
September 19 - 28, 2025 * 10 DAYS/ 22 MEALS



Experience three iconic National Parks on this Northern Rocky Mountain adventure to Yellowstone, Glacier and Grand Teton. We fly from Boston to Spokane, Washington to begin our journey, experiencing the spectacular glacial lakes of **Coeur d'Alene** and a sunset dinner cruise on Lake Coeur d'Alene. We'll also visit the Mission of the Sacred Heart, oldest building in Idaho dating to 1850. On Day 3 we cross into Big Sky Country and arrive in **Kalispell, Montana** to experience two days visiting **Glacier National Park**. Highlights include the Continental Divide, the glacially carved Garden Wall and incredible mountain ranges, glaciers, waterfalls and wildflowers. Another highlight will be dinner at the famed **Lonesome Dove Ranch** to enjoy country gourmet cooking, roaming buffalo and a horse rescue operation. Our next destination is **Butte, Montana**, where we enjoy lunch, visit a former copper mine and the **World Museum of Mining** which contains 50 buildings and countless artifacts. Our **Yellowstone** adventure begins the next morning as we tour the **Upper Loop** of the park with visits to Yellowstone's Park Headquarters, one-of-a-kind **Mammoth Terraces**, **Mammoth Hot Springs**, **Tower Falls** and the **Grand Canyon of Yellowstone** among other sites. We check into the **Kelly Inn** for two nights – the closest hotel

to the west entrance of Yellowstone – convenient to shops, restaurants, the IMAX Theater and Grizzly Wolf Discovery Center. Our guided Yellowstone touring continues the next day highlighted by **Old Faithful Geyser**, **Painted Pots** and perhaps the **Prismatic Hot Spring**. We ride through pristine mountain wilderness and open refuge such as **Hayden Valley** to view wildlife including grizzly bear, elk, American bison and moose. On Day 8 we depart from Yellowstone to visit **Grand Teton National Park**, with photo stops at Jackson Lake Overlook and Colter Bay Village. At **Jackson Lake Lodge** we will gaze upon the breathtaking Teton range followed by lunch in the historic **Mural Room**. The murals illustrate the 1837 Rendezvous, an annual gathering

of fur trappers and traders of the early West. Later we check into the **49'er Inn & Suites** set amidst Jackson's downtown, brimming with shops, art galleries, night spots and the famous "Cowboy Bar". Tonight enjoy a **Covered Wagon Cookout and Show** in beautiful Cache Creek Canyon. We have free time in Jackson the next morning before departing for **Salt Lake City, Utah**. We spend our last night at the **Embassy Suites** where we will enjoy a Manager's **cocktail reception** and **farewell dinner**. After breakfast and check-out on Day 10 we experience a live performance of the famous **Mormon Tabernacle Choir!** An afternoon flight to Boston will bring us home late evening.
